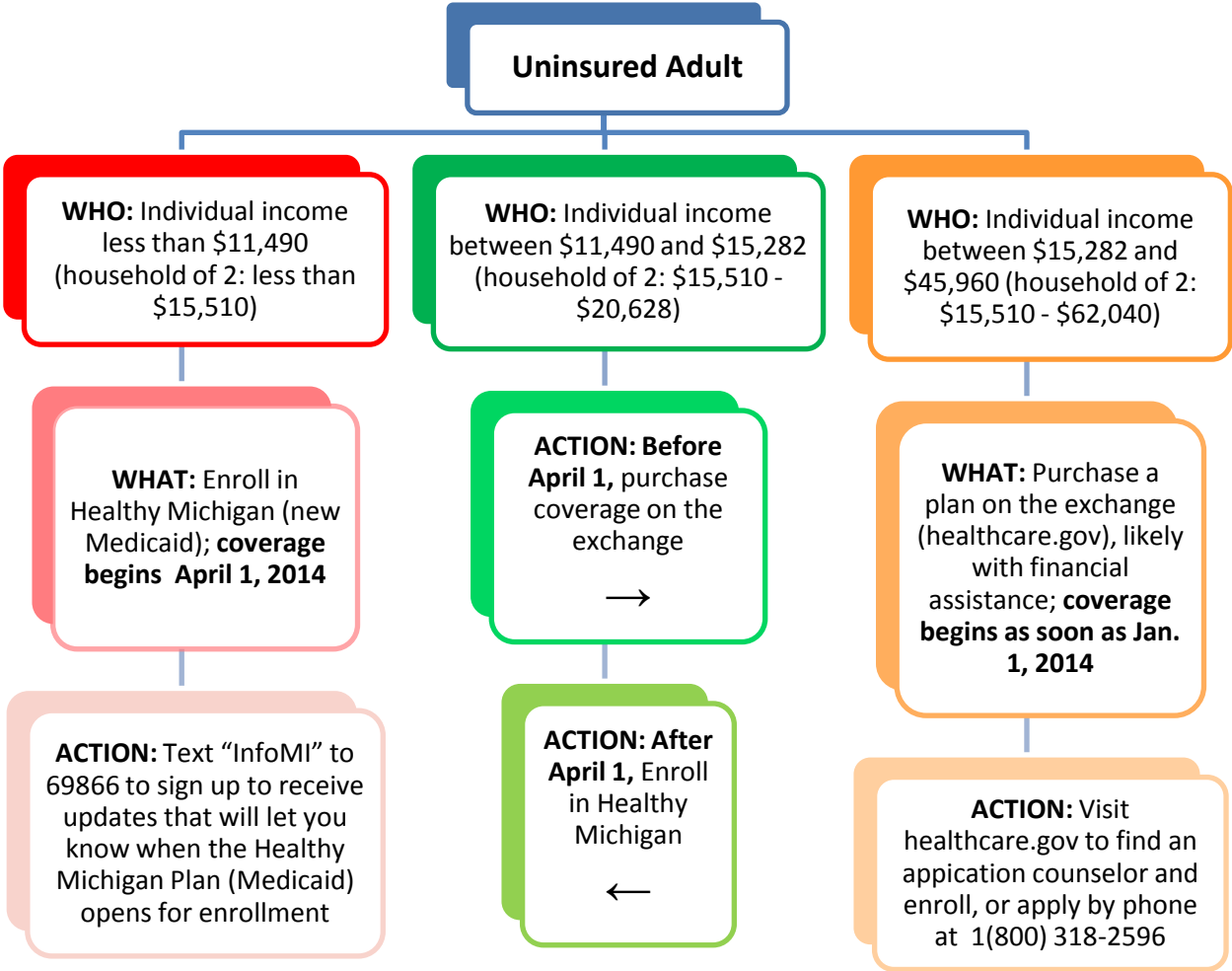


Starting in 2014 new, affordable health insurance will be available to Michigan adults.

In April 2014, adults making less than about \$15,300 a year can get low-cost or free coverage in the new Healthy Michigan plan. But even if you aren't eligible for Healthy Michigan, there are affordable options for you – and all of them cover preventive care, doctor visits, mental health and substance use care, hospital stays and more. And, the insurance companies cannot deny you coverage if you have a health issue now.
